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Regional Screening Criteria

- 1) All sexually active women under age 25
- 2) Women age 25 and older with one or more of the following:
 - *New sex partner in the last 60 days
 - *Multiple sex partners in the last 60 days
 - *MPC
 - *Cervical Friability
 - *PID
 - *Positive for Chlamydia in the last 12 months

Background

States in Region:

Regional Advisory Council (RAC) Membership:

3 Representatives from each state; one from STD, one from Family Planning, and one from lab

Workgroup Priorities:

Lab Services
