Region VIII Goal & National IPP Priority

Region VIII Goal & National IPP Priority Area:

Target/expand Chlamydia screening to young sexually active women and men at risk for infection in public and private settings.

- Objective 1: Conduct a regional assessment to establish baseline information regarding the provision of CT/GC screenings during a pregnancy-test only visit (PTO).
- Objective 2: Disseminate a regional epidemiologic profile of pregnancy-testing only clients seen in prevalence monitoring clinics.
