- Next issues
 - Eliminate male testing that is paid for by IPP
 - Reduce screening in women older than 26 (testing symptomatic only)
 - EPT for all patients
 - Suspend repeat testing of women if EPT
 - Cost-sharing with patient service fees and specimen analysis
 - Stop testing at juvenile detention
 - Refer patients to counties for express testing & free treatment
 - Consider specimen analysis by other labs
 - Eliminate funding to sites/delegates with positivity < 3%

CLINICAL SERVICES - Objective # 1

4-year target (2008): Chlamydia screening rate for women 25 and under seen in Title X AFPC clinics will increase to 70% by the end of 2008.

Status: Target not achieved. 61% of women aged 25 and under (See Table 2).

2009 target: CT/GC screening rate for women 25 and under will increase to 85% by the end of 2009. This matches IPP Region IX Priority Area 3.

CLINICAL SERVICES - Objective # 2:

4-year target (2008): Obtain a 90% chart documentation of direction to client to return for re-testing in 90 days.

Status: Target not achieved. In 2008, AFPC conducted 4 site visits (6 health centers).

2009 target: Obtain 90% chart documentation of direction to client to return for re-testing in 90 days.

CDC Objective #1: The proportion of women with positive Chlamydia tests who are treated within 14 and 30 days of the date of specimen collection (IPP-CS2).

4-year target (2008): 80% at 0 to 14 days and 10% at 15 to 30 days **OR** Cumulative - 90% at 0-30 days.

Status: Target not achieved. Results from the chart reviews for the four delegates visited in 2008 show the following:

1. 61% (27 of 44) were treated within 14 days and 23% (10 of 44) between 15 and 30 days.

2009 target: 85% at 0 to 14 days and 10% at 15 to 30 days **OR** Cumulative - 95% at 0-30 days.

LABORATORY SUPPORT - Objective # 1

Revised 4-year target (2008): Increase the proportion of Chlamydia testing using APTIMA Combo test kits for female family planning clients to 45%.

Status: Target achieved. In 2008, 59% of the tests used for females in family planning clinics were the APTIMA Combo test.

2009 target: 100% of the tests performed at the Title X health care center will be using a blood sample for the APTIMA Combo tests.

SURVEILLANCE AND DATA MANAGEMENT - Objective # 2

1 year Target (2008): Achieve a greater than 90% match rate between the state lab and the delegates AFPC Title X encounter data.

Status: Target not achieved: Table bellow shows matching results between the state lab and the AFPC Title X encounter data for the four quarters of 2008.

2009 target: The objective is to have a greater than 90% match rate between the state lab and the AFPC Title X encounter data for all the delegates.

AFPC IPP Guidelines – Quick Guide

The implementation of a protocol for screening, testing, treatment and re-testing of Chlamydia is required to comply with the AFPC IPP guidelines.

Note:

- If CDI or any other agency takes over the follow-up, the health center is still responsible of recording treatment and re-testing.
- The implementation of a protocol for screening, testing, treatment and re-testing of Chlamydia is required to comply with the IPP AFPC guidelines.

The AFPC IPP protocol requires the following information in the client's chart:

- date of visit (test);
- if female client is 26 or older, reason to justify the test;
- date clinic notified of test result;
- test result;
- dated lab test result in chart.

If the Chlamydia test result is positive:

- the attempt to notify client within one day of receipt of positive result;
- date when client was reached;
- number of attempts made to reach/notify client;
- notification to the local STD program or CDI within 5 working days of test receipt of positive client was not reached:
- a copy of the morbidity card in client's chart;
- date of treatment;
- treatment drug administered;
- documentation of client education on medication and instructions;
- documentation of client counseling regarding partner treatment;
- documentation advising client of need for retesting in 90 days.

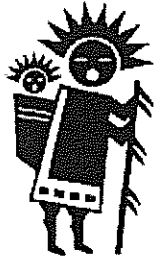
